

EMAS MORNING TOUR AROUND TOWER BRIDGE

Thursday, 22nd February 2018

A tour of Tower bridge has been arranged in order to bring more industrial archaeology into the EMAS programme of visits.

Tower Bridge is a combined bascule and suspension bridge. The two bridge towers are joined together at the higher level by two horizontal walkways. The bascule pivots and operating machinery are in the base of each tower.

Tower bridge was constructed between 1886 and 1894, the latter date being the grand opening by the Prince and Princess of Wales.

The last renovation of Tower bridge was in 2010 and now it is open to the public. A member of the staff will give us a personally guided tour.

The tour is from 10am – 11am. We will meet by the ticket office at the bridge from 9.40am to go in at 10am. The tour caters for 15 people at a cost of £11.00 per person for EMAS members and £12.10 for non members.

I am sorry this tour cannot be on a Saturday, but special group tours are not available on a Saturday.
